The Skipton Swimathon Committee has chosen to jointly support the Priaulx Premature Baby Foundation and the Citizen's Advice as the 2021 beneficiaries.

The PPBF now owns two apartments adjacent to Southampton Hospital, where they provide free accommodation for local families with premature babies and sick children seeking vital treatment. The Skipton Swimathon's aim is to support the full running costs of at least one of these for the next twelve months.

Citizens Advice are desperately in need of funding to enable them to upgrade their IT system. It has become outdated over the 43 years of their existence and during the recent lockdowns the CAB was unable to continue with their invaluable advisory service due to the outdated system.

In order to show recognition for the hard efforts spent raising funds and to give you something back, we
